What is an acquittal?

An acquittal is a process that helps recipients of Gove Community Giving funding demonstrate how they used the funds and how their initiative aligned with the approved application.

This helps Rio Tinto monitor the social, community and economic impacts of the program.

When is the acquittal due?

The acquittal is due within six weeks of the completion of your initiative or expending of the funds.

What do you need to provide?

Please provide the following:

- A completed Rio Tinto acquittal form
- Tax invoice/s to support the expenditure
- Summary of the successes
- Photography (inclusive of photography consent) to allow for Rio Tinto internal and external promotion
- Photos (Note: A signed release form is required for any photos so that we can promote in Rio Tinto communications).
